

# Art full text

## *Art full text contains:*

- abstracts and bibliographic records for articles from periodicals published throughout the world, including English-language periodicals, yearbooks, and museum bulletins, as well as periodicals published in French, Italian, German, Japanese, Spanish, Dutch, and Swedish
- records indexed from 1984, abstracts from 1994 and **selected** full-text coverage from 1997.

## *Use Art full text to find:*

- references to articles about advertising, art, antiques, archaeology, architecture and architectural history, art history, computers in art, crafts, decorative arts, fashion design, folk art, graphic arts, industrial design, interior design, landscape architecture, motion pictures, museology, non-western art, painting, photography, pottery, sculpture, television, textiles, video
- links to full text for selected articles.

## *Tips:*

- Use **advanced search** to build a complex search.
- If you enter more than one term, the words are treated as a phrase.
- Use the **Descriptors** field for subject searching.
- Use the **Artist and Work** field to search for artists and/or the illustrations which accompany articles.
- Limit your search by setting limits, eg limit to articles published after 2002.
- **Not** all articles are available in full text; click **Check for full text** link.
- Restricted to 8 simultaneous users; if you cannot gain access try again later.

## *Look for similar information in:*

- ARTbibliographies modern
- Avery index to architectural periodicals
- JSTOR – the scholarly journal archive.
