

# Avery index to architectural periodicals

## *Avery index contains:*

- a comprehensive listing of journal articles on architecture and design
- coverage from 1934.

## *Use Avery index to find:*

- references to journal articles about history and practice of architecture, landscape architecture, city planning, historic preservation, and interior design and decoration
- links to full text for selected articles.

## *Tips:*

- Select **Advanced Search**.
- Construct a search using synonyms.
- Use the subject/artists field to focus the search.
- Use \* to find variations of a word, eg architect\* finds architecture, architectural.
- Use \* to find spelling variations, eg col\*r finds colour, color.
- Save marked records as .txt file and import to EndNoteX1 via filter file.

## *Look for similar information in:*

- Art full text
- ARTbibliographies modern
- DAAI design and applied arts index.
