A+ Education contains:

- information on educational research
- information on teaching and training
- information on policy administration
- information on educational psychology.

Use A+ Education to find:

- full text articles and comprehensively indexed journals
- bibliographic details of books from 1978 onwards, with links to the catalogue
- research reports, conference papers and dissertations
- scholarly research on popular topics such as bullying, TESOL, etc.

Tips:

- Limiting to Full Content Records Only (full text) may exclude relevant titles available via other sources at Monash University Library.
- Click the Manage Search History link to view all your recent searches, then the Save link to rerun your search at a later time.
- Click the Thesauri tab to locate correct search terms.
- The Databases tab links to other Informit databases which can be listed in subject order.
- Save relevant records and export them to Endnote by selecting Endnote Direct from the Output Format drop-down menu.
- Help is available from the Help and Search hints links.
