
ERIC contains:

- indexed and annotated bibliographic records (citations, abstracts, and full text links) 1966 +
- indexed citations from more than 600 journals in the Education field (EJ)
- indexed citations and pdf links to reports, policy papers and reviews (ED)
- US focus with some international coverage.

Use ERIC to find:

- journal articles on many topics - school curriculum, governance, ESL, ICT
- research syntheses in areas such as “self concept in transition settings”
- conference and policy papers relating to education issues from maths in elementary school curriculum to globalisation and educational change.

Tips:

- Click  if a PDF is not apparently linked to a selected article.
- Use the descriptors listed alongside your search results to refine the relevance of articles found.
- Tools tab includes thesaurus - check search terms for use in subject (de) field.
- Use * for various spellings, eg school* retrieves school, schools, schooling.
- Use **Search History** link to save and manage results or create an **Alert** to be notified of new citations matching your search criteria.
- Save marked records as .txt file and import to EndNoteX2 via filter file.
