OT seeker contains:

- Information on Evidence-based Occupational Therapy
- Abstracts of systematic reviews and randomised controlled trials (RCTs).

Use OT seeker to find:

- citations relevant to Occupational Therapy interventions
- critical appraisal of all RCTs
- information about evidence-based practice
- links to other sites about evidence-based practice.

Tips:

- Help is available from the OT seeker Power Point tutorial on the home page.
- Search using keywords or **intervention** and **diagnosis/subdiscipline** boxes.
- Limit searches by criteria such as year or methodological score.
- Select articles required. Full text articles may sometimes be available from links on the **Detailed Search Results** page, or via the Monash University Library catalogue.
- Find instructions for downloading documents or exporting results to Endnote on the **Detailed Search Results** page.

Look for similar information in:

- OTDBase
- OvidMEDLINE
- PubMed
- CINAHL plus.
