International pharmaceutical abstracts contains:

- Journal citations and abstracts from over 800 pharmaceutical and health related journals worldwide from 1971 onwards
- Coverage includes drug reactions, toxicity, investigational drugs, drug evaluations, drug interactions, biopharmaceuticals, pharmaceuticals, drug stability, pharmacology, preliminary drug testing, pharmaceutical chemistry, drug analysis, drug metabolism, pharmacognosy, and methodology.

Use International pharmaceutical abstracts to find:

- citations and links to journal articles, conference papers, symposium, books and book chapters and reports
- access to European, Australian and New Zealand as well as Asian and South East Asian material not readily available elsewhere

Tips:

- Use * as a truncation symbol to expand your search eg patent* finds patent, patents, patented.
- Quick Search defaults to an anywhere search looking in any field for records including full-text.
- Advanced Search allows limiting search by years of publication, language, and journal articles only.
- Advanced Search allows searching in multiple search boxes for alternative words eg arthritis or knee injur* or patella injur*.
- Click the Search Tips button for more useful tips.

- Meditext.
